REGISTRATION

- Registration is on a first come, first served basis
- Limited space in each program
- Participant form/waiver and field trip permission form is required
- You will not be able to register multiple families
- At least one half of the registration fee is due at the time of registration. If ½ of balance is not paid at registration, you will not be able to register your child.
- Payment Plans are available. If registration fee is not paid in full by the session start date your child **will not** be able to **attend** program until balance is paid.

When picking up participants from any Hillside program, our **Late Fee Policy** is \$1/minute after the first 5 minutes.

Adjusted Fee

The adjusted fee and payment plan programs were established to allow Recreation Services to serve more people fairly and efficiently. Adjusted fees are available for activities exceeding a registration cost of \$25. Adjusted fees for camps is available for qualifying families. Proof of approval for one of the following programs is required: free/reduced lunch program, LEAP, TNIF, SSI/SSDI OR proof of income for 2015/2016. Call for application prior to registering.
